Kahurangi Estate is a family owned boutique vineyard and winery specialising in hand-made wines and dedicated to quality. The vineyard was first planted in 1973 and has some of the oldest commercial wines in the south Island.

Kahurangi is a Maori word with a number of translations, two being "treasured possession" and "precious jewel". The Logo is a stylised reproduction of the Nikau Palm, which proliferates in the valleys and west coast beaches of the Kahurangi National Park. The Nikau Palm was a treasured source of food and flax to the indigenous Maori tribes in the South Island.



### Winemakers Notes

Vineyard	Selected vineyards, from Moutere Clay and gentle sloping hills of the Waimea Plains.
Soil	Predominantly Moutere Clay with a mix of Stony Alluvial.
Vintage Conditions	An outstanding summer provided near perfect conditions, producing some of the highest quality grapes in vintage history. The result of this quality vintage shows wines which express vibrancy, fruit concentration and complexity.
Harvest Date	Early April 2013
Fermentation / Maturation	100% Stainless Steel with cool ferment
Alcohol	13.5%
Residual sugar	9.34 g/L
Total Acidity	4.5 g/L
