Winemakers Notes

Vineyard	Single Vineyard on the Nelson plains.
Soil	Stony Alluvial
Vintage Conditions	An outstanding vintage with perfect conditions. Phenolic ripeness was reached earlier than usual, resulting in one of the earliest harvests in the Nelson Region. Resulting fruit was ripe, clean and of excellent condition, producing wines which express vibrancy, fruit concentration and complexity.
Harvest Date	5th April 2014
Fermentation/maturation	100% Stainless steel with no malolactic fermentation
Alcohol	13.5 %
Total Acidity	6.9 g/L
Residual Sugar	3 g/L

Tasting Notes

	Clean tropical characters with stone fruit flavours balanced with hints of lime and a fresh finish.
General Comments	A lovely, refreshing, crisp wine with no oak influence.

Hue	Clear light straw.
Nose	Ripe nectarine and tropical fruit
Palate	Nectarine, stone fruit with hints of lime.
Length	Crisp and lingering
Cellar	Up to 3 years
